



USPI Announces Latest CMS 'Hospital Compare' Ranking for its Surgical Hospitals

Majority of surgical hospital platform achieves a five-star rating

DALLAS – May 5, 2021 – United Surgical Partners International (USPI), a subsidiary of Tenet Healthcare Corporation (NYSE: THC), today announced patient experience scores for its surgical hospitals in the most recent Hospital Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (HCAHPS) star ratings. The HCAHPS ratings were recently released by The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).

Out of USPI's 23 eligible surgical hospitals, 22 earned a four- or five-star rating, with 16 of those earning five stars.

HCAHPS star ratings are based on patient surveys that cover many areas related to patient experience. That includes nursing and physician communications, responsiveness of staff to patient needs, facility cleanliness and whether a patient is likely to recommend a hospital to others.
